Auction / Raffle - Foundation

Mindy from the Foundation speaks about the Auction. Foundation was founded to fill a funding gap, pays for part of violin, part of Spanish, and all of Orff. Auction generally makes \$40,000-\$50,000 each year.

The raffle was aimed at non school families (broader community). This year there is no raffle coordinator, if no one steps into this role then the raffle will not occur this year.

They are also looking for Auction Chairs, ie people who have specific major roles in putting on the Auction. Looking to bring in people to train over the next few years so that when these ladies' children graduate they have knowledgeable successors.

They also need regular volunteers for smaller bits of Auction work.

<u>Keepsakes</u> - PTA

Lori spoke about Keepsakes. It is quite a bit of work, but the results and what the parents get out of it are great. If someone wanted to take over you take photos of their artwork and then parents can choose to put it on a variety of mediums (keychains, magnets, coffee cups). The most work is coordinating, taking photos of artwork, and then matching children's artwork to the kids' names. There is company that Linwood uses. Wouldn't make as much money, but it would still be fundraiser.

Volunteering - Both Foundation and PTA

Our school is heavily volunteer based.

We are looking for a Volunteer Coordinator. This person should be great at reaching out to people. Need to work with a website. Social Media. They should be a good communicator. Allie, the former Volunteer Coordinator is still here for one more year to train her successor. It could also be multiple people. Both boards as well as the office are looking for one person to come to with volunteers, and or volunteer questions.

Enrichment Night - PTA

Last year we did about three Enrichment Nights. We would need a committee. These evenings are not fundraisers, they are just fun times for the families. Lori says this is an easy position. She suggests about three people split it. Mindy suggests that we put three Enrichment Nights out there and ask for volunteers to run each.

Directory -PTA

Last two years Lori did this. Lori has the excel spreadsheet. It would just need be updated a bit. Folks like to get this as quickly as possible. This could also be handled by a team as opposed to an individual.

<u> Green Team - PTA</u>
